Location / Schedule / Format:

Practices are held on Monday's for one hour at the North fields at DiCaprio Park unless a change of location is requested by your coach.

Games are played each Saturday beginning Sept. 19th and ending Oct. 31st. For the number of players on the field, roster size, and game duration, please refer to the chart at the bottom of this page.

Players are placed on teams and play against other teams based on their grade in school.

Families will be contacted two weeks before the first game with information regarding their coach, practice, and game schedule.

The Guilderland United Recreation Program adheres to the guidelines set forth by the United States Soccer Federation our governing body.

Who is Eligible?

All children in kindergarten through fifth grade who live in or attend school in the Town of Guilderland. The league is recreational in nature and open to all skill levels. All players receive equal playing time and will have the opportunity to play all positions on the field if desired.

How to Register:

Parents may either “click” on the registration link on the website to register online or they can print off a registration form from the front of the website and mail it in with a check made out to *Guilderland United Recreation League*. The check should include the registration and uniform fees. A copy of your child's birth certificate will be required before they can begin practice in the fall.

Coaching:

Coaches are parent volunteers and must complete a coaching class taught by our club's Director of Coaching. The club provides Professional Licensed Coaches to support those parent coaches who would like some guidance or help. Mentor Coaches from the Guilderland High School Boys and Girls Varsity Soccer Teams will also be used as mentors for the players to help with the teaching of skills and to build a link between our youth and senior programs.
